

Spooky Spider Pin

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Make a
Tarantula
sized spider.

Materials:

3/4" (2 cm) Black Bead
3/8" (1 cm) Black Bead
Pin finding (as shown here)
20 Gauge Wire (Black would be Best)
24 or 26 Gauge Wire (same color as above)
About 150 Size 6 Black Seed Beads
24 Size 6 Brown Seed Beads



Black wire will look best, but I've used silver color to make it easier for you to see the wire work.

Cut a piece of 20 gauge wire about 6" long and make a tiny loop at the end as shown here.

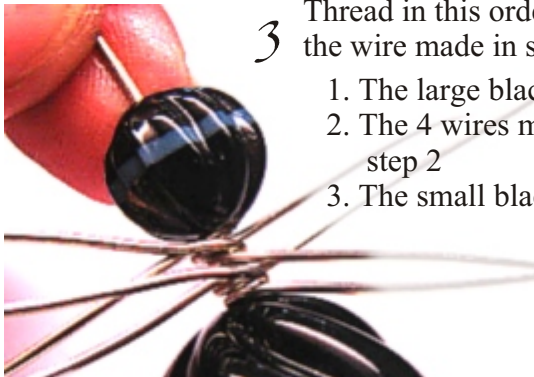
Cut 8 pieces of 20 gauge wire and make a very tiny loop in the center using needle nose pliers.

Thread in this order onto the wire made in step 1:

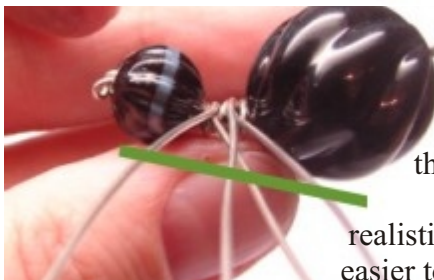
1. The large black bead
2. The 4 wires made in step 2
3. The small black bead



Hold everything onto the wire by making another small loop at the top of the spider - try to tuck it in and make it as unobtrusive as possible (this is another reason for using the black wire). I marked my loop with the green arrow. And the legs aren't finished here, I just forgot the picture earlier. Oops.



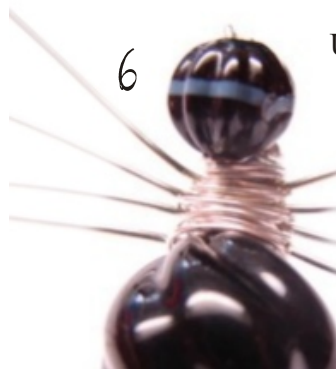
Repeat for the other 7 legs. Shape them like spider legs.



Bend the wires up so that you have a flat underside for the spider, as shown by the green line here. This makes it look more realistic, and makes it MUCH easier to wire the pin onto him

Using the small wire, smoothly wire the pin finding onto the spider body as shown here. I went around a couple of times to insure a nice smooth body for him. Again, Black wire will hide a myriad of flaws. Also, you might want to tape the stick part of the pin out of your way and open, so you won't wire it shut. (And yes, it happened my first time)



Thread seed beads on leg in this order (Total 19 beads)
5 Black 1 Brown and repeat 2 more times then put one last Black Bead.

Repeat for the other 7 legs. Shape them like spider legs.
